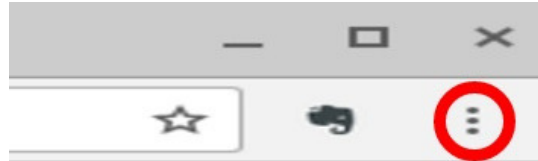


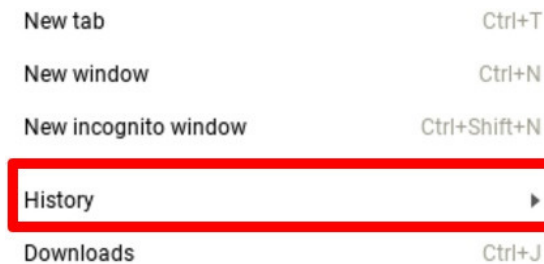
How to Clear Your Browser History

For Google Chrome:

Step 1: Click on the **three dots** in the top right corner of your browser.



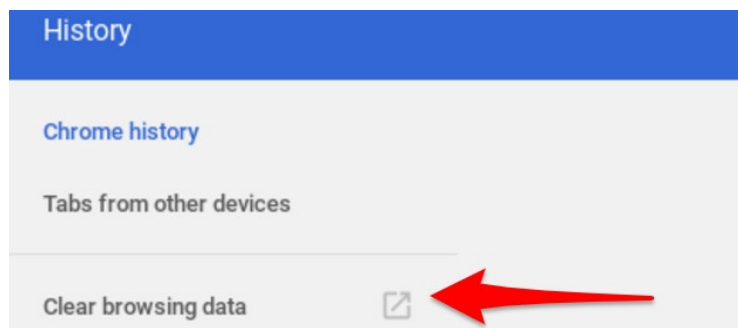
Step 2: Select **History** from the drop down menu.



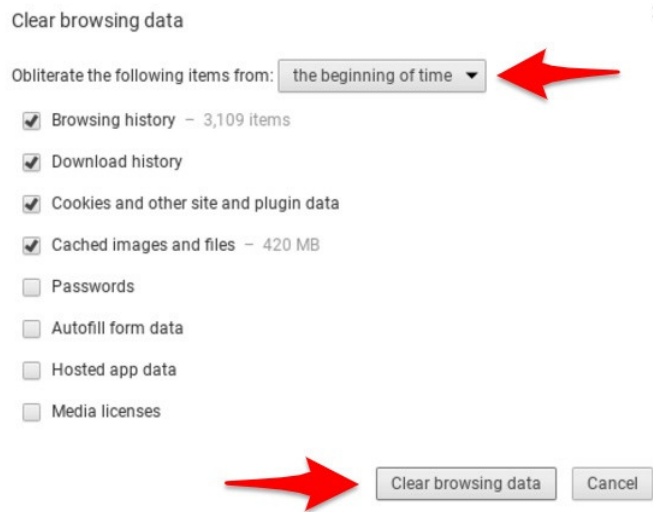
Step 3: Select **History** again from this new menu to view your history's details.



Step 4: In the top left corner of your screen, click on **Clear browsing data**.

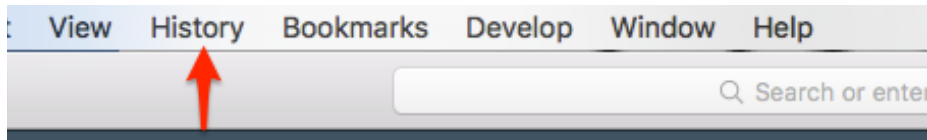


Step 5: Use the drop-down menu to choose how far back you'd like to delete your browsing data and specify which information you'd like to delete, then click the **Clear browsing data** button.

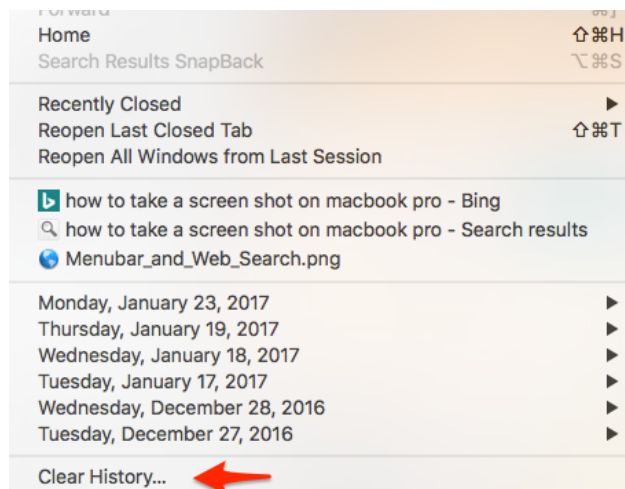


For Safari:

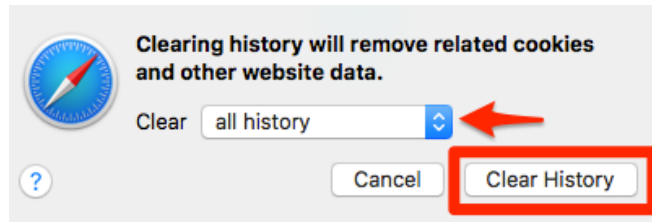
Step 1: Click on **History** at the top of your screen.

Step 3: Use the drop-down menu to choose how far back you'd like to delete your browsing data and specify which history you'd like to delete, then click the **Clear History** button.

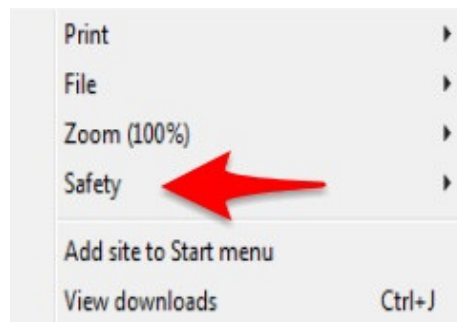


For Internet Explorer:

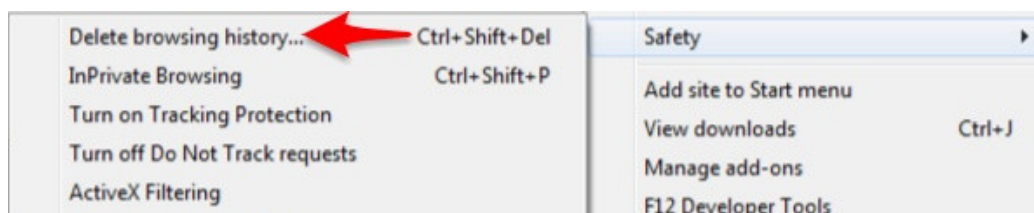
Step 1: Click the **Settings** gear in the top right corner of your browser.
